Our trusted volunteers attend funeral services, at the family's request, where donations can be made in lieu of flowers. These donations help us invest in critical cancer research and support for the benefit of all South Australians. This volunteering opportunity requires you to attend funeral services across metropolitan Adelaide and collect donations on behalf of Cancer Council SA.

On the day of the funeral, you will collect resources from Cancer Council SA offices before heading to the funeral location. Upon arrival you liaise with funeral directors on their preferred location. Once set up you will liaise with family and friends in a professional, caring manner assisting potential donors complete forms as required. All resources and donations will be returned to the Cancer Council office following the funeral.

You will need to be flexible with your availability as funerals may be on any weekday or weekend between 9am and 5pm.

Additional requirements:

- driver's license (C)
- good communication and interpersonal skills and a friendly and approachable personality to deal with this sensitive time
- positive 'Can-do' attitude capable of providing excellent customer service
- basic WHS and manual handling knowledge
- ability to work independently and within team environments.

You will be required to travel to various locations in a Cancer Council vehicle in the Adelaide metropolitan area.
